On 03/08/2020 the Quality Assurance Unit (MODIP) of the University of Patras concluded the audit of the internal assessment procedures of the Undergraduate Programme of Studies (UPS) of the School Of Medicine as foreseen by the provisions of the National Law 4957/2022 (Article 215, paragraph 4) and the Internal Quality Assurance System of the University.

The quality data and the evidence on which the audit was based were as follows:

2. The Quality data available in the National Information System for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (NISQA) of HAHE for the academic year in reference.
3. The quality target setting of the academic year in reference.

The auditing of the above by the MODIP's officers in charge evinced that the completion of the internal evaluation process was lawful, followed the principles of the Institution's Internal Quality Assurance System and was in accordance with the Standards of the Hellenic Authority of Higher Education (HAHE). In addition, it was ascertained that the Internal Evaluation procedure of the Programme led to the:

1. Documented illustration of the Programme's achievements.
2. Highlighting of points that need improvement.
3. Specification of applicable improvement actions.
4. Possibility of taking initiatives for independent action for improvement within the Programme.
5. Decision making on further independent actions within the School and/or the University, to improve the work provided by the Programme's work if and where possible.

IDENTIFIED FINDINGS

STRONG POINTS

- The first at national level School of Medicine study programme fully certified by the national authority (ADIP) without any comments (Fully Compliant).
- High number of international student mobilities under the Erasmus+ Program: 26 incoming and 42 outgoing Erasmus students (34 student mobilities for studies abroad and 8 student mobilities for traineeship).
- Extroversion and high scientific level of the programme's academic staff. Amongst all the departments of the University of Patras, the School of Medicine is rated 1st in the number of scientific publications and reports and 2nd in attracting external competitive funding of all kinds.
- High quality according to international standards. The School of Medicine has managed to remain stable in positions 351-400 and be among the top 3% of the best Medical Schools worldwide.

WEAK POINTS

- Technical limitations, such as the lack of network connection in some of the teaching rooms, which as a result limit the utilization of online resources for interactive teaching in courses where related infrastructure is required.

SUGGESTED CORRECTIVE AND PREVENTIVE ACTIONS

Preventive-corrective actions:

1. Maintain the highly qualitative and extrovert academic-scientific profile through continuous and active participation in European and international research programs, scientific actions and networks.
2. Enhance the technological infrastructure and the e-content accessibility.

IDENTIFIED FINDINGS

STRONG POINTS

- Successful implementation of distance education due to the pandemic, delivered over the institutional e-platform, meeting all the requirements for synchronous and asynchronous learning. The responsiveness of the academic community had impressive results in a very short time.
- High graduation rate.
- Facilitation of an excellent research environment, ensuring the continuation of the School's ascending progress in all its scientific fields.
- Highly rated research and scientific performance, as the School of Medicine maintains the first position within the University regarding the number of publications and the second in attracting external funding.
- Notable number of 36 student mobilities, during the academic year 2019-2020, under the ERASMUS+ program.
- Significant infrastructure procurement: the European Bank approved the supply of scientific equipment of a total amount of 1,500,000 euros, for Clinical Operations Laboratories.

WEAK POINTS

- In the conditions of the COVID-19 pandemic, within the context of the distinct educational function of the School of Medicine and the intensified clinical activity, the disposal of data by the faculty members on their research and scientific work was done to a less satisfactory extent, compared to previous years.

SUGGESTED CORRECTIVE AND PREVENTIVE ACTIONS

Preventive-corrective actions:

3. Ensure the provision of up-to-date information regarding the research and scientific work by the faculty members.
4. Exploit the full potential of the new infrastructure as well as of the blended education knowhow and resources.

IDENTIFIED FINDINGS

STRONG POINTS

- Consistently high graduation rate.
- Successful implementation of distance learning system during the winter semester, due to the covid-19 pandemic. The response of the teaching and other staff had impressive results in a very short period of time.
- Implementation of the incoming student mobility and Internship using distance education methods, without the physical presence of the students at the University of Patras, or a combination of physical and virtual form of mobility (blended), as deemed necessary, for the winter semester of the academic year 2020-2021.
- Participation of a significant number of the Programme's academic and research staff as invited speakers at national and international conferences.
- High rates of student's participation in the evaluation process and the completion of online questionnaires contributing to the improvement of the Programme.
- Reinforced extroversion, via the students' mobilities under ERASMUS+ and their active participation in the Hellenic Medical Students' International Committee (HelMSIC).

WEAK POINTS

- Reduced number of the School's/Programme's faculty members.

- Increased level of the faculty members' responses, compared to the previous years, regarding the provision of data on their research and academic work.
- Upgraded website (<http://www.med.upatras.gr>), to function as the main information gate and enhance the global visibility and accessibility of the School and the Programme.
- The majority of the Programme's teaching staff provide a large part of the courses material in digital format and exploits the existing digital education tools (<https://eclass.upatras.gr/>).
- Notable participation of a significant number of faculty members as invited speakers in national and international scientific conferences.
- Managed to remain consistently in the 351-400 ranks and among the top 3% of Medical Schools worldwide for the past 6 academic years.
- 20 ERASMUS+ student mobilities, providing excellent opportunities to gain work experience and seek a specialty abroad.

WEAK POINTS

- Reduced number of the School's/Programme's faculty members.
