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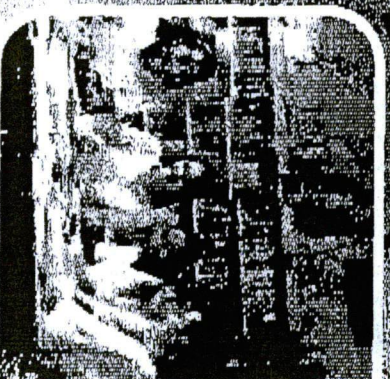
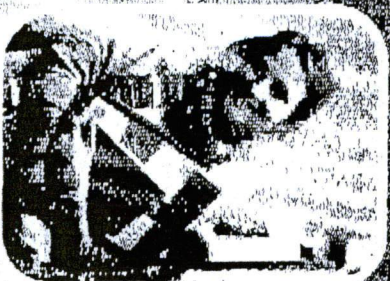

People: Applicants for Scholarship Stays in Slovakia

What is offered?

- **scholarships** covering costs related to a study stay (1-2 semesters) of foreign university students at a Slovak university during their Master's studies
- related to a study/teaching stay (1-12 months) of PhD students from abroad at university research organizations at a university or research organization in Slovakia during their PhD studies
- related to teaching research or artistic stay (1-12 months) of university teachers, researchers of artistic fields from foreign universities/research organizations at a university or research organization in Slovakia

Individuals with permanent residence in Slovakia and citizens of the Slovak Republic studying or working at universities or research organizations abroad are eligible for the following countries for foreign applicants:

Citizens of which countries are eligible?

Others, such as the following countries, are eligible for the stay: Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, China, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Georgia, Greece, Hungary, India, Israel, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Macedonia, Malta, Mexico, Moldova, Montenegro, Norway, Pakistan, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, and the United Kingdom.

What is the amount of a scholarship?

- a) university students: 450 €
- b) PhD students: 300 €
- c) university teacher, researcher or artist: 500 €

- PhD degree holders: 4 years of work experience: 500 €
- with PhD degree and less than 10 years of work experience: 450 €
- with PhD degree and more than 10 years of work experience: 500 €

The amount of a scholarship shall cover average living costs of a scholarship holder.

How to apply?

Applicants shall apply online at www.scholarships.sk. System opens registration 6 weeks before the deadline. After submitting an online application form with all attachments, applicant shall send original hard copy of his/her application letter to SAA in a sealed envelope by the day of the application deadline. Information on application forms, required documents and sending requirements for the application shall be found at the Program website.

What are the deadlines for submitting application forms?

- 30 April by 6:00 CET - scholarship stays for the next academic year
- 31 October by 16:00 CET - scholarship stays for the winter semester of the upcoming academic year

What is offered?

- **scholarships** covering living costs related to a study stay (1-2 semesters) of 1-2 continuing Slovak university students during their Master's studies
- related to a teaching/teaching stay (1-12 months) of PhD students from Slovakia at research organizations abroad during their study stay

- **Travel grants** - to cover living and travel costs related to a study stay (1-2 semesters) of 1-2 continuing Slovak university students during their Master's studies

Which country can you choose for your scholarship stay?

The programme is for students from Slovakia who are continuing their studies abroad. The scholarship stay can be in any country of the world.

What is the amount of a scholarship?

The amount of a scholarship is based on the average living costs of a student in the country of the scholarship stay. The grant will be a fixed sum, just one amount for the whole stay abroad. The amount of the grant will be found at the Program website.

At www.scholarships.sk a list of countries and the amount of the scholarship is already being prepared.

What is the amount of a travel grant?

Travel grant is a fixed sum related to travel costs to and from a scholarship stay. Scholarship stay shall be at least 100 km from the place of residence. The grant will be a fixed sum, just one amount for the whole stay abroad. The amount of the grant will be found at the Program website.

How to apply?

Applicants shall apply online at www.scholarships.sk. System opens registration 6 weeks before the deadline. After submitting an online application form with all attachments, applicant shall send original signed hard copy of his/her application letter to SAA in a sealed envelope by the day of the application deadline. Information on application forms, required documents and sending requirements for the application shall be found at the Program website.

What are the deadlines for submitting application forms?

- 30 April by 6:00 CET - scholarship stays for the next academic year
- 31 October by 16:00 CET - scholarship stays for the winter semester of the upcoming academic year
